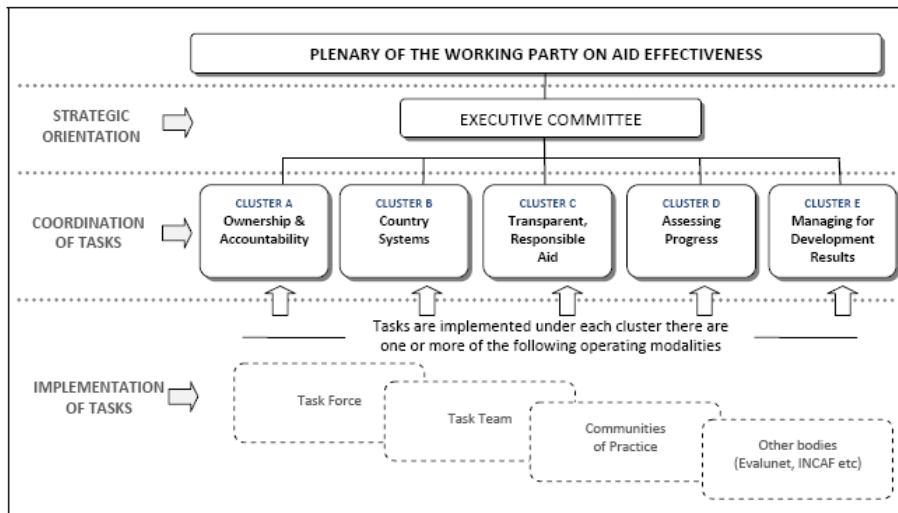

	TASK FORCE (ex Joint Ventures)	TASK TEAM	COMMUNITIES OF PRACTICE	OTHER BODIES
<i>Definition</i>	A dedicated constituency charged with delivering a work programme in a specific field (e.g. public financial management).	A small group charged with delivering a specific time-bound task.	An informal network or platform for knowledge exchange and capacity development.	Bodies or networks that are established outside of the Working Party on Aid Effectiveness. This includes for example the Network on Evaluation.
<i>Chairing</i>	One or more Co-Chairs.	Team leader(s) in charge of delivering a task	No formal chairing arrangements.	
<i>Member</i>	30-40 donor and partner country representatives	A group of 10-15 volunteers in charge of delivering an output.	Network will range from 10 to potentially hundreds of members.	
<i>Programme or Tasks</i>	A work programme is agreed and is implemented by the Task Force.	Single time-bound tasks (e.g. delivering a good practice paper).	No formal programme of work. The Communities of Practice are dedicated to sharing knowledge and experience.	
<i>Meetings</i>	Regular meetings either in Paris (OECD) or elsewhere. These may be supplemented by virtual meetings when deemed necessary.	Exchanges are mainly electronic but might also include meetings usually on an ad hoc basis.	No formal meetings. Exchanges are based on electronic communication.
