Objective of DCPR

DCPR's overarching objective is to track progress in development partnerships and provide evidence-based analysis of trends in development cooperation to guide our efforts in strengthening partnerships to support the implementation of the RS III and the NSDP.



Data sources of DCPR

Country Level:

- a) ODA Database (data extracted in March) DP/NGO disbursement trends
- b) NSDP alignment (based on resource required)
- c) Industrial Development Policy (IDP)
- d) Cross-cutting issues (climate change, gender equality, private sector)
- e) Second Round of Busan monitoring survey Cambodia inputs

Global Level:

- a) Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and its financing "the Third International Conference on Financing for Development (FfD)"
- b) Other relevant items of global researches

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Structure of DCPR

- 1. Introduction: reflects evolution of development cooperation architecture at global and national levels, addresses its challenges and opportunities
- 2. Trend in Development Cooperation: (total disbursement by DPs/sectors, aid modalities, alignment of ODA with national priorities, NGOs support to national development, TWG profiles etc)
- 3. Result-Based Partnerships: a reflection on commitments by individual DP against the Busan partnership indicators
- 4. Cross Cutting Thematic Profiles: (Emerging sector for IDP, Climate Change Finance, Gender equality, Agriculture)
- 5. Emerging sector for IDP: (DP funding to support IDP)
- 6. Conclusion: (summary, roles and institutional arrangements, policy recommendation)



Process of DCPR

- (DPs) data update/validation: till end of 2015, CRDB/CDC outreach team has well supported the process
- (CDC) data validation process: early 2016
- The analysis stage begins in March 2016
- CRDB/CDC will produce draft report during Q2 of 2016.
